Rachel's Joy was started in 1989 and has continued to provide services for pregnant women and babies as an alternative to abortion. Services such as housing, clothing, mentoring, counseling and all needs for the new mothers as they raise their children. The Ministry was founded and continues to be directed by Susan Mirti-Fusco under the covering of Acts Community Development Corporation and the support of Coney Island Lighthouse Mission of Brooklyn, New York.

Now Rachel's Joy, in collaboration with Harvesters in Sport, will be able to reach children in Zimbabwe who have no parents or family, providing them with caring support, food, clothing, housing and a Christian education. Our hope is to change lives through the Zimbabwe orphanage.

Apostle Susan is highly respected and known as a pastor, preacher and Apostle. Apostle Susan is the executive director and founder of Rachel's Joy Maternity Home and now Rachel's Joy Maternity Ministries in New York City. What this orphanage project is about

Rachel's Joy Maternity Ministries is seeking to work collaboratively with Harvesters in Sport and Mugove Chiviya to build and maintain an orphanage in Darwendale, Zimbabwe, Africa for orphaned children.

Once the orphanage is built by Rachel's Joy, Harvesters in Sport will acquire financing to build a school on the same parcel of land.

It is a very sad reality that these orphaned children face this because even their own relatives abandon them and can't look after them due to their own struggles with poverty.


Without a solid foundation and place to live these children could end up in sex trafficking or homeless, without food, shelter or education.

The land for our orphanage has been cleared and ready for the foundation.


Seen here is the land before and after being cleared.








Architectural drawings of the orphanage

Scale 1:100




Side Elevation




Side Elevation

The work of the orphanage has begun

How we are already assisting the children in Zimbabwe





Rachel's Joy is already assisting children through our work with Harvesters in Sport.

Here is how we are already helping them.

And what we can provide through the building of the orphanage



Harvesters in Sport feed on average 65 children per day and over 200 on weekends.







Right now we are providing emotional support to these orphaned children.

Harvesters in Sport has this year sent 35 kids to school and supplied stationery and school uniforms at a cost of US \$7,500.00. These are considered on a case by case basis.





Right now, through Harvesters in Sport, we have begun sharing the love of Christ and providing these children with some of their basic needs.

Apart from feeding and sending some of them to school they play fun games, get taught sports and life skills.





Harvesters in Sport will provide trained house mothers and supervise them according to government requirements. Harvesters will also set up a screening process for the selection of orphans and the final selection will be done in conjunction with Rachel's Joy.





Right now we are providing supervised sporting activities mainly

- Football (Soccer), Volleyball and Netball.
- They periodically hold mini sporting tournaments to encourage participation in sport. We can never know which area gives a child the most emotional support



These children's are alone in the world, with this orphanage we can provide

- Housing, beds, blankets, desks, tables, a gas stove, a solar power system for lighting.
- Education
- Clothing
- A safe environment
- Caring friends to help them
- Teaching for the future



These limited benefits we are providing are making a difference for these orphaned children.
